

How many times can you see me in the upper case HUNE? How many times can you see me in the lower case HUNE? $\qquad$ -


Just like there are many of me in the HUNE letters above, this letter can make many sounds. Usually, HUNE says " $v$ ". Nayree will tell you the rest of the sounds.

HUNE does not have any words that begin with it. But it is a very important letter. It makes many sounds and, the sound depends on what letter is beside it. Trace on the dotted arrows to follow and learn about the sounds. Also, look on pages 40 and 57 of your workbook to learn more.


A When $h L$ is at the end of the word or before vowels: $\omega, t, 5, \square, h, n, o$.

B When $/ 7 L$ is before a consonant.
